Our volunteers are building databases of farms that are willing to donate surplus produce to local food banks. Then one hundred percent of individual donations go towards moving food from A to B, paying farm workers to pick and pack food and drivers to deliver it.

If food waste were a country, it would be the third largest contributor to global greenhouse gas emissions in the entire world.

So every pound of food we keep away from waste and put on tables makes a real difference.

We've achieved a lot so quickly and now we want to build an even larger impact. Since I joined Accenture in November. I've received incredible support from people at all levels of the business.
